Requirements for the design of articles are posted on the conference website <http://m3e2.ccjournals.eu/2019/> (see sections “Primary requirements” and “Formatting options”) and in the appendix.

To participate in the conference, it is necessary before March 31, 2019 to register and submit an article on the site (see annex), as well as send a request to e-mail abdanylchuk@gmail.com (+80634499986, Danylchuk Hanna).

The organizing committee of the conference requests no later than 10 days before the conference to inform about the date of arrival and the number of participants who will arrive at the conference.

Registration fee includes:

- a) for each participant - a registration fee covering all sections, coffee breaks, printed versions of the conference program and participation certificate (400 UAH);
- b) for the authors of the accepted articles - payment for publication (60 euros).

Application

To submit materials, authors need to log into the EasyChair system at <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=m3e22019>. If the author has never worked with EasyChair and is not registered in it, you must click on the "create an account" link of the login form. After creating an account, you need to log in to EasyChair — you will be redirected to the M3E2 2019 conference area as the author. On the New Submission page of the M3E2 2019 conference, fill in the details of the article according to the instructions.

Articles must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1) originality - the article should not be previously published or submitted for publication;
- 2) at least one author of the article should present it at the conference;
- 3) a participant in a conference can have a maximum of two articles in a group of authors;
- 4) group of authors - no more than 5 participants;
- 5) the number of links - not less than 10;
- 6) self-quoted from the list of sources should not exceed 10%;
- 7) the volume of the article is from 6 to 8 pages according to the template https://www.shs-conferences.org/doc_journal/woc/woc_2col.doc;
- 8) articles must meet the SHS Web of Conferences Editorial Guidelines (https://www.shs-conferences.org/doc_journal/woc/shsconf_editorial_guidelines.pdf);
- 9) links must be in MathPhySci format (https://www.springer.com/cda/content/document/cda_downloadaddocument/Key_Style_Points_MathPhysRef.pdf);
- 10) the deadline for submitting articles is March 31, 2019, 23:59:00.

Each article will be reviewed at the end of the deadline for compliance with the minimum requirements and the following criteria:

1. Correspondence to the M3E2 conference theme.
2. The level of scientific novelty.
3. Literacy.
4. Structuring an article.
5. The content of the title.
6. Informativeness of the annotation, the presence in it of the main results and conclusions.
7. The quality of illustrations.
8. The completeness and novelty of the sources.
9. The quality of scientific English presentation.

On April 21, 2019, all authors who submitted articles before March 31, 2019 will receive the decision of the program committee on the rejection or preliminary acceptance of the article.

Until April 30, 2019, authors of previously accepted articles will have to finalize them taking into account the comments and suggestions of reviewers and upload the final version of the article to EasyChair along with the form for transferring copyright to the publisher signed by at least one author of the article.
